2020 National Blue Ribbon School Award: Altoona Intermediate School is Among the Highest Performers Nationwide in "Closing the Gaps"

Today, 367 schools were recognized nationwide as 2020 National Blue Ribbon Schools, and Altoona Intermediate School, serving grades 4-5, is among them, one of just eight schools to earn this honor in Wisconsin.

The U.S. Education Department recognizes the award-winning schools in one of two performance categories, based on all student scores, student subgroup scores and graduation rates: Exemplary High Performing Schools, and Exemplary Achievement Gap Closing Schools, the category of Altoona Intermediate School's award.

The coveted award affirms the hard work of educators, families and communities in creating safe and welcoming schools where students master challenging and engaging content.
